

## **Air Programmer**

The Air Programmer is responsible for our inclusive challenge course programming including; giant swing, high ropes, zip line, climbing wall, bouldering wall, low ropes, and team building course/games. They will ensure the safety of all participants through proactive risk management and following industry guidelines for best practice. Together with the Elements Team, they will work to plan and run evening programming, special events and other activities as required. The Elements team is also in charge of the set up/take down/cleaning of all programming and meals as well as helping the counsellors in dorms.

### Expectations

- Plan, prepare and deliver inclusive, creative and themed challenge course programming.
- Guarantees participant/staff safety and works within industry scope of practice.
- Maintain all challenge course equipment, including course inspections.
- Complete all associated forms for Air programs.
- Plan and run CYOA's & Cabin Choice's.
- With the Elements team, plan and run evening programming/special events.
- Effectively manage both their time and the Air Assistant's time.
- Plan sessions to be delivered during staff training regarding Air programming.
- Teach staff how to assist in facilitating Air programs.
- Consult and review all risk management, equipment and technical questions with Program Manager.
- Reports to the Program Coordinator.

### Required Qualifications

- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Experience working with people with various forms of disability
- Extensive experience leading inclusive challenge course activities
- Excellent risk and group management skills
- Excellent ability to organize and prioritize own and others' work

### Certifications considered to be an asset

- ACCT Level 1 Ropes Instructor/Accessible Ropes Training Course –or equivalent experience
- Standard First Aid & CPR
