Counsellors are responsible for assisting campers with any personal care needs, facilitate games and activities for campers, and are always prepared to put the preferences and comforts of our campers before their own. Our counselling staff have a crucial role in the success of the camper's summer camp experience. Bonding with campers, building relationships, experiencing heart-filled moments, and seeing first-hand the lasting effects that camp has on our campers are just some of the perks of this position!
