

Volunteer Coordinator

The Volunteer Coordinator is responsible for recruiting, vetting, training, organizing and overseeing summer volunteers, Horizon Mentors participants and summer interns. They supervise and support their volunteers and participants, acting as a resource, providing direction and leadership in order to foster the volunteers' development within the camp setting. They collect and manage the storage or alumni information, maintaining communication with the camp alumni and volunteers to keep them informed of what's going on at camp. The Volunteer Coordinator is responsible for planning and organizing any alumni events, such as an Alumni Retreat. They report directly to the Manager, Resources and maintains regular communication. The Volunteer Coordinator is considered Senior Staff and are required to assume additional responsibilities in this position. This position requires a lot of organization, excellent leadership, energy and positivity, all of which are essential for successful candidates.

Required Qualifications:

- Standard First Aid & CPR 'C'
- Class 4 Drivers License (or equivalent)
- Significant experience working at a camp or in a similar recreation setting

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience working with people with disabilities
- Supervisory experience
