

Water Programmer

The Water Programmer is responsible for planning, preparing and delivering inclusive and creative aquatic programming including, lifeguarding and water related games and activities. They will be responsible for the safety and well being of aquatic participants at all times. The Water Programmer is apart of the Elements Team. Together they plan and run evening programming, special events and other activities as required. The Elements team is also in charge of the set up/take down/cleaning of all programming and meals as well as helping the counsellors in dorms.

Expectations

- Plan, prepare and deliver inclusive aquatic programming, including lifeguarding, water games and creative aquatic programming.
- Ensure safety of all participants through proactive risk management and following industry guidelines.
- Maintain all aquatic equipment, including cleaning and sanitizing the pool house.
- Complete all associated forms for Water programs.
- Plan and run CYOA's & Cabin Choice's.
- With Elements team, work to plan and run evening programming/special events.
- Effectively manage their time.
- Plan sessions to be delivered during staff training regarding Water programming.
- Teach staff how to assist in facilitating Water programs.
- Review risk management, equipment and technical questions in consultation the Program Manager.
- Reports to the Program Coordinator.

- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
- Experience working with people with various forms of disability
- Extensive experience leading inclusive aquatic activities
- Excellent risk and group management skills
- Excellent ability to organize and prioritize own and others' work

- Standard First Aid & CPR
