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

Your Booking Journey at Easter Seals Camp Horizon

We want your experience with us to feel easy, transparent, and supportive from the moment you reach out. Below is a simple guide to what you can expect at each step of the booking process.

How the Process Works

1	You contact us with a booking inquiry.	Today!
2	We'll send you a Booking Request Details Form to gather the basic information we need to get started.	Right after we receive your inquiry.
3	We'll send your official Camp Horizon Booking Contract and all related documents.	Once we have collected all details.
4	You submit your non-refundable deposit of \$500 and a signed copy of the Easter Seals Camp Horizon Booking Contract.	As soon as possible! Booking dates are secured once we receive this.
5	You submit your final preparation documents, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Certificate of Insurance;• Submission of signed waivers from all participants• Group dietary information (If applicable)• And any other documents requested	2 weeks prior to your arrival.
6	Submission of final payment.	Final day of booking prior to departure.

Insurance Requirements

To keep everyone safe and protected during your stay, we require a Certificate of Insurance from all visiting groups.

Your Certificate of Insurance must:

- Be signed and dated by an authorized representative
- List Easter Seals Camp Horizon as “Additional Insured”
- Include all policy details (liability coverage, limits, and coverage period)
- Reflect a minimum of \$2,000,000 liability coverage
- Include the exact dates of your visit (or reference a blanket contract for recurring bookings)
- Clearly state “Certificate of Insurance” – other documents like policies or confirmation letters are not accepted

If we do not receive a valid Certificate of Insurance before your group arrives, we may not be able to allow entry.

Final Invoice/Payment

On the final day of your booking prior to departure, the primary contact of your booking will be provided a final invoice.

Your invoice may be adjusted to reflect any additional charges incurred during your stay (i.e. a higher guest number than originally planned, damages, added activities, etc.).

Outdoor Experience Packages

Our Outdoor Experience Package is designed to make planning your group's visit simple, memorable, and budget-friendly. Each package is priced per person, so you can easily estimate costs and build a trip that fits your group's needs.

Every Outdoor Experience Package at Camp Horizon includes:

- A dedicated host to support your group throughout your stay
- Meals for all participants
 - *Overnight packages include meals from lunch on your first day through breakfast on your final day*
- A set number of activities based on the length of your stay
- One complimentary chaperone for every 10 participants
 - *(Additional chaperones will be charged at the standard package rate)*

Package pricing is calculated per person and includes accommodations, meals, and scheduled activities.

Additional fees apply for optional add-ons such as extra or alternative activities, breakout spaces, or additional meals.

All Outdoor Experience Packages require a minimum of 20 participants.

Accommodations

Wolf's Den & Eagle's Nest: These two identical accommodations designed for comfort and convenience. Each building is divided into two sides that sleep 20, each with its own large shared bathroom. A spacious central common area connects the two sides, creating a perfect gathering space. Each corner of the building features a chaperone room with two sleeping spaces and a private ensuite bathroom.

Capacity: 48 per building.

Venture Lodge: Offers a cozy, home-away-from-home feel with a generous common room complete with games, a dining table, a television, and a fully equipped kitchen for groups wishing to prepare their own meals.

Capacity: 20. Note: there may be blackout dates for this building.

Wapiti Lodge: One of the original buildings on site, Wapiti Lodge brings rustic mountain charm to your stay. With individual rooms (each with one or more bunk beds) and plenty of character, it's a warm and welcoming space guaranteed to make long-lasting memories during your stay here.

Capacity: 20. Note: there may be blackout dates for this building.

Yurts: Tucked slightly up the hill in a forested area, our yurts offer the perfect blend of adventure and comfort. These round, canvas-covered structures sit on wooden platforms and are outfitted with bunk beds. The yurt village includes a central firepit, two outhouses, and a potable water faucet. It is a short walk from the main buildings and indoor washroom facilities.

Capacity: 10 per yurt.

Moose Lodge: This space brings together all the best parts of a classic camp stay – cozy rooms, plenty of bunk beds, and a welcoming common area perfect for games, late-night chats, or winding down after a full day of adventure. It's spacious, friendly, and full of that unmistakable "camp magic" that makes memories stick.

Capacity: 36.

Buildings & Amenities

Main Hall: Our Main Hall is the heart of camp – a bright, flexible space that can become almost anything your group dreams up. While it's often our bustling dining area, it can easily transform into a dance floor, concert venue, wedding space, meeting hall, or community hub. If you can imagine it, we can probably host it here. Capacity: 120.

Arts & Crafts: The Arts & Crafts Building is where creativity comes to life. Split into a “wet side” for painting and messy masterpieces and a “dry side” for crafting and calmer activities, it's a versatile spot that adapts to your group's needs. A small kitchenette makes it perfect for food prep, baking projects, or snack-fueled art sessions. Capacity: 30.

Amphitheatre: Nestled between our main buildings, the amphitheatre is a flexible outdoor gathering space – great for group meetings, performances, reflections, or simply enjoying the mountain air.

Fire Pits: The main fire pit sits just behind Moose Lodge, offering a stunning mountain backdrop, wooden bleachers, and a sturdy metal grill – perfect for s'mores, songs, and stargazing. Additional fire pits can be found at the Yurt Village and Timber Falls campsite for groups seeking a more tucked-away campfire experience.

Main Field: This wide-open green space is ready for anything: outdoor games, team-building activities, group challenges, or simply a sunny spot to gather and unwind. It's the perfect place to spread out and enjoy the fresh mountain air.

Activity Price List

All activities are led by our trained facilitator staff to ensure a fun, safe, and engaging experience for everyone. Most activities can accommodate up to 20 participants per activity period, with the exception of wide games, which can include larger groups.

Commonly Asked Questions

“Can we change the allotted time for an activity?”

Some activities, especially our ropes and harnessed programs, require set timeframes to ensure proper safety briefings, equipment checks, and harnessing.

For all other activities, please speak with our Program Lead and we'll do our best to accommodate your schedule.

“Is there WI-FI on site?”

Yes! Camp Horizon does have Wi-Fi, though due to our mountain location the signal can be weaker at times. We encourage participants to unplug and enjoy the outdoor experience, but we understand that some guests may need access.

We simply ask that high-bandwidth usage (like streaming or gaming) be avoided during our office hours (8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.).

“Can we bring our own Snack/Meals?”

Yes, groups are welcome to bring their own food. Please note that our site is not nut-free, but we are allergy-aware. We take nut allergies very seriously and work with participants to reduce risks wherever possible.

We also ask that food is not eaten in dorm rooms, as it can attract wildlife we'd prefer stays outdoors.

If you need refrigerator or storage space for food you've brought, please let our Program Lead know and we will be happy to help.
